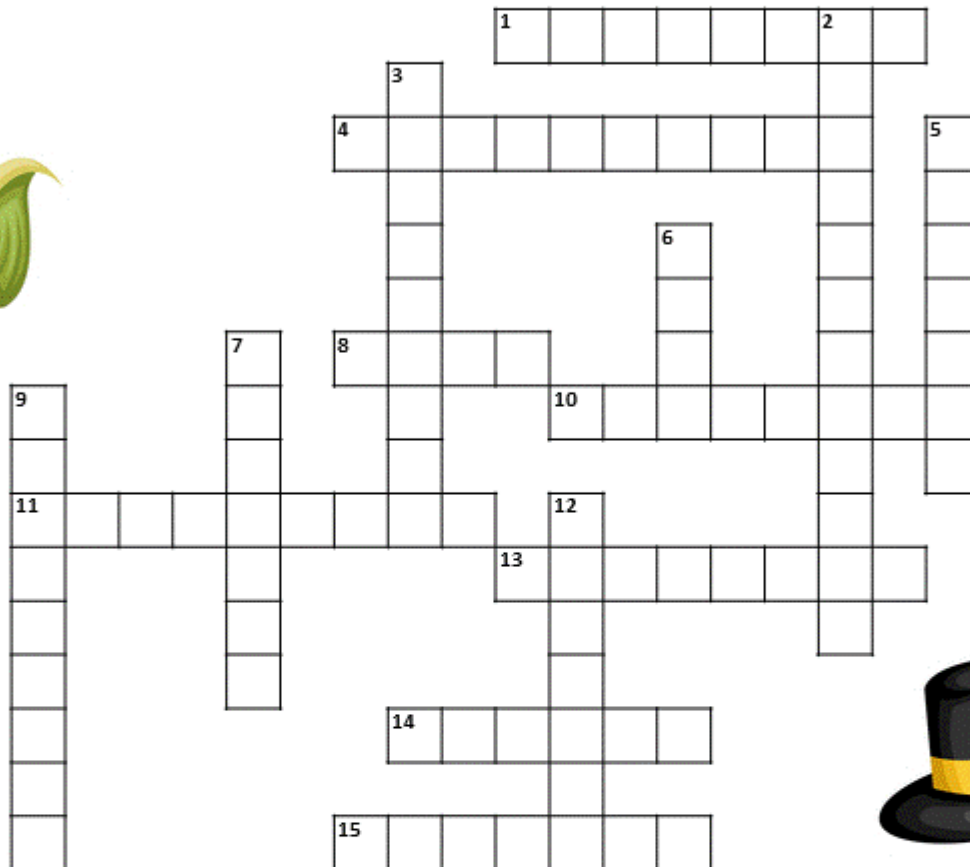




# Thanksgiving Crossword
